Parking:

Parking can be the most difficult part of attending a meeting in any downtown area. We want to make your visit as pleasant as possible and make your trip to the City of West Palm Beach less stressful. We will cover the expense of covered parking in the City parking garage for your visit. The process is simple and a map is below. When you pull into the garage, located at 500 Banyan Blvd/501 Clematis St, you will press the button on the machine to obtain an electronic “chipcoin” which looks like a poker chip about the size of a quarter. Bring the coin with you to the training and we will validate it. Upon exit, you simply deposit the coin into the machine and the gate arm will open.

Restaurants:

Location of the training:

The actual training is scheduled in the room known as the Flagler Gallery. The room is located on the first floor of the City of West Palm Beach City Hall. As you clear security, head toward the right as you go through the rotunda. You will then pass through a double door with restroom on the right and then will go to the right into the Flagler Gallery.
