See the Event Details on the **FFMA Event Calendar** for more information! This four-day course is designed to provide an organized training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain management ordinances.

The course will focus on the National Flood Insurance Program, the concepts of sound floodplain management, Flood Insurance Rate Maps and Flood Insurance Studies, ordinance administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance. The L-273 Course is for enhancement and/or a refresher of the material only and not intended to prepare someone for the Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM) Certified Floodplain Manager (CFM) exam.

The CFM exam will be offered the morning following the L-273 Course.

Selection Criteria

Local officials responsible for administering floodplain management ordinances, local including but not limited to floodplain management administrators. building inspectors, code enforcement/zoning officers, planners, city/county managers, attorneys, public engineers, and works officials. Federal/state/regional floodplain managers also are encouraged to attend. The course is designed for those officials with limited floodplain management experience.
